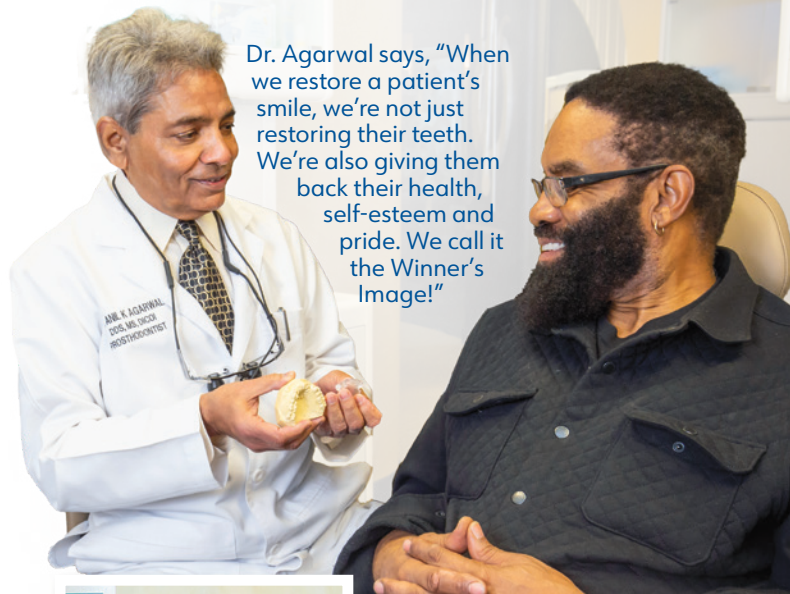

In addition to being a prosthodontist, Dr. Agarwal is a Fellow and Diplomate

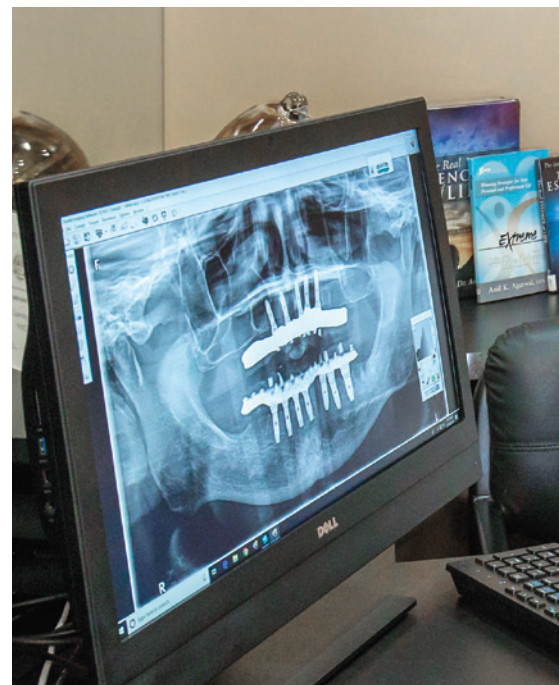
of the International Congress of Oral Implantologists. He plans and executes implant treatments in collaboration with the other specialists at the practice.

Prosthodontists are experts in planning complex cases. For more extensive implant cases, such as replacing a full arch of teeth, Dr. Agarwal and Dr. Arbabi work with Dr. Cummings, the practice’s board-certified periodontist, and Dr. Hamedani, a board-certified oral and maxillofacial surgeon with many years of experience in implant surgery.

“All our doctors are specialists in the placement of implants and the creation of new teeth,” says Dr. Agarwal. “This knowledge and expertise—from implant planning to finished new teeth—allows us to deliver a higher level of care to our patients, all from a single office.”

Precise Implant Planning for Perfect Placement

The doctors use advanced 3D technology to make the procedure efficient and minimally invasive, and to ensure the accuracy of implant treatment. Using a state-of-the-art 3D CT scanner, they



capture detailed 360-degree X-rays of the patient’s entire mouth and jaw. 3D software allows the doctors to map out the exact position of each implant, simulating the entire procedure. If needed, the doctors create a surgical guide to use during the procedure to aid in implant placement.

Comfortable, Relaxed Treatment

Patients are provided with various amenities to ensure they are comfortable and relaxed at all times, including pillows, blankets, water and music. For fearful or anxious patients, IV sedation and deep sedation are available.

Before treatment begins, the doctors explain the entire procedure, answering any questions. “They’re all very reassuring,” says Tanya, a dental implant patient. “They give very detailed explanations of the entire process and make you feel so comfortable.”

implant placement and the creation of new teeth, the doctors are experts who know how the new teeth should look and function. The crowns, bridges or dentures that will attach to the implants are fabricated using a certified dental lab, which uses only high-quality materials to ensure long-lasting comfort and fit. All technical and quality control is overseen by an expert lab technician.

The new teeth look, feel and act like natural teeth. "You can't tell I have them," says Winnie, an implant patient. "They look perfectly normal."

Benefits of Dental Implants

Compared with other tooth replacement options, dental implants are the most reliable, longest lasting and most realistic-looking option for replacing missing teeth.

Between them, the doctors have extensive training and experience replacing missing teeth and treating the gum tissue and bone that support teeth. As prosthodontists, Dr. Agarwal and Dr. Arbabi are experts in cosmetic dentistry—they make sure the new teeth are correctly positioned to be functional, and look natural and aesthetic.

“We are rigorously trained in replacing teeth,” says Dr. Agarwal. “We use the best methods and materials, and take our time to craft new teeth that not only look aesthetically pleasing but are correctly aligned and comfortable. Nothing is finalized until the patient is completely happy with them.”

No Added Cost for Additional Implants

Some procedures use four implants per arch, but the number of implants placed can vary depending upon the availability of sufficient bone and the treatment goals. “More often, we place five or six

in an arch,” says Dr. Agarwal. “We use the number of implants that will give the patient strong and stable teeth. No matter how many implants are placed, the price for the procedure remains the same.”

Successful Full-Arch Treatment

The extensive planning the doctors do is key to the success of providing All-on-X. Using a state-of-the-art 3D CT scanner, they take 360-degree views of the patient’s mouth and jaw to identify the areas of densest bone and determine the best locations to place the implants.

The doctors then use implant-planning software to simulate the entire surgery ahead of time and can even create a surgical guide, which is placed over the gums during the procedure to ensure implants are placed precisely.

The implants are placed in areas of dense bone in the jaw. They may be placed at an angle to provide optimal stability and minimize the need for bone grafting.

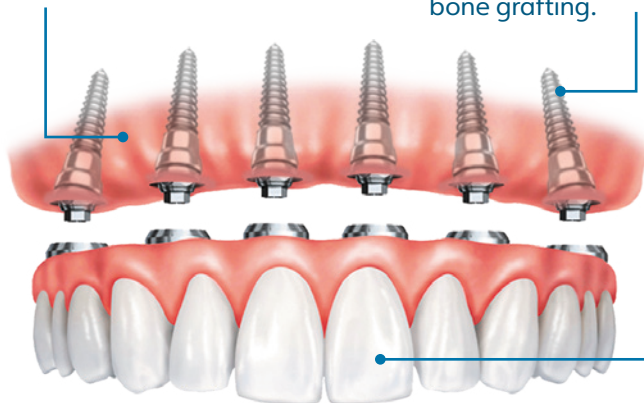


The doctors recommend the best treatment option and answer any questions the patient may have.

All-on-X Full-Arch Teeth Replacement

Four to six implants are placed in areas with an adequate volume of dense bone for maximum support.

Long, angled dental implants maximize bone-to-implant contact and increase stability, often eliminating the need for bone grafting.



The new teeth are made out of durable and natural-looking materials. They are crafted into one unit so the load is evenly distributed and chewing power is strong.

Increased Chewing Power and Beautiful New Teeth

For most patients, the doctors attach provisional new teeth during the same visit as the implant surgery. These temporary teeth look lifelike and are fully functional. After the implant sites heal, the final teeth are placed, providing patients with close-to-natural biting and chewing strength.

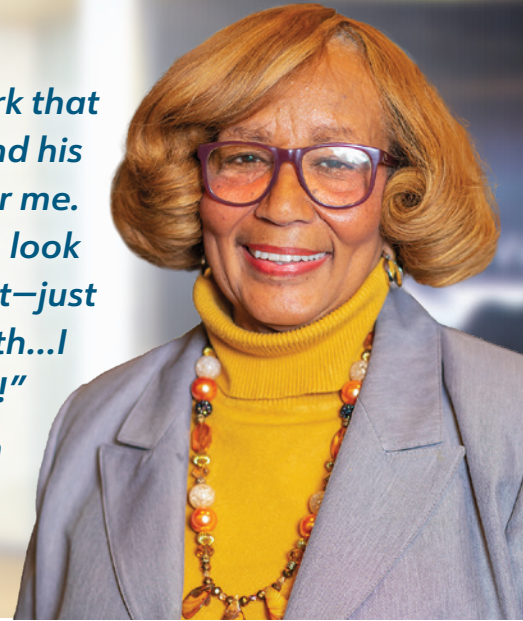

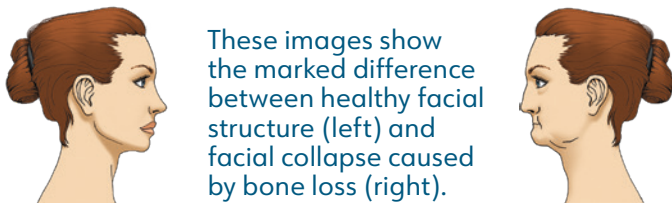
Implant-supported teeth look, act and feel like natural teeth—people usually don't notice any difference between their natural teeth and their implant-supported teeth.

"My new teeth feel like my regular teeth!" says Gwendolyn, an implant patient. "I can smile and I don't have to take things in and out."

Missing Teeth = Bone Loss

Failure to replace missing teeth—and wearing dentures—results in bone loss. Without the stimulation of full-force chewing, bone gradually reabsorbs back into the body.

Wearing dentures escalates this process, due to the constant friction of the denture on the bony ridge. Eventually, so much bone is lost that the lower part of the face recedes. The chin moves toward the nose, and the mouth and cheeks sink in, causing facial sagging, deep wrinkles and folds and a prematurely aged appearance.



These images show the marked difference between healthy facial structure (left) and facial collapse caused by bone loss (right).

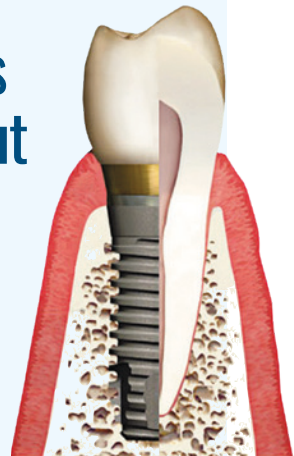
Dental Implants Are the Solution

Replacing missing teeth with dental implants solidly anchored into the jawbone prevents this bone loss from occurring. The implants and the chewing force they provide keep the jawbone stimulated and healthy. Patients can once again enjoy carefree eating, talking and smiling.

Dr. Agarwal Answers Your Questions About Dental Implants

What is a dental implant?

"Dental implants are artificial tooth roots made of titanium. We place the implant in the jawbone and attach a crown, dental bridge or denture."



Is the procedure painful?

"Most of our patients report little to no discomfort. They often return to work and their usual activities the next day. We're committed to patient comfort, and we offer IV and deep sedation, as needed."

What success rate can I expect?

"For a healthy individual with good oral hygiene and good health, dental implants have a predictable success rate above 95%."

How long will they last?

"We offer a 10-year guarantee on patients' implants, but this is rarely needed. With proper care, dental implants have been proven to last over 40 years."

Will they look like normal teeth?

"The teeth attached to dental implants are fabricated using only high-quality materials that look, feel and function like natural teeth."

Have You Been Told You're Not a Candidate For Dental Implants?

Dr. Agarwal has a solution very few dentists offer—he can provide **ZYGOMATIC IMPLANTS** for patients who have been told they don't have enough bone for implant treatment.

Gum disease, smoking, leaving teeth missing and wearing dentures can all contribute to bone loss. Patients who have suffered bone loss in the jaw may not be eligible for traditional dental implant treatment, but this doesn't mean there is no hope for getting a stable smile. Using zygomatic implants, an advanced form of implant treatment, the doctors at Winterset Dental can restore full function and beauty, even for patients who have been wearing dentures for a long time.

A Stable Foundation for Full-Arch Teeth Replacement

When bone in the upper jaw is insufficient to support dental implants, Dr. Agarwal can place extra-long, angled implants in the cheekbone (zygomatic bone), where the bone volume remains dense even when teeth have been missing for a long time. He can then attach a full arch of natural-looking replacement teeth—a strong and long-lasting solution for patients who have extensive bone loss.

In use for over 20 years, zygomatic implants have been proven safe and effective and can be placed without the need for bone grafting or sinus lifts, which can add months to the treatment time of traditional implants. The zygomatic implants integrate with the bone and are so strong that a full set of replacement teeth can usually be attached right away.

With new teeth firmly fixed to the zygomatic implants, patients are able to stop worrying that their teeth will slip or fall out. They can enjoy a wide variety of foods they couldn't eat with dentures, and they can once again smile with confidence.

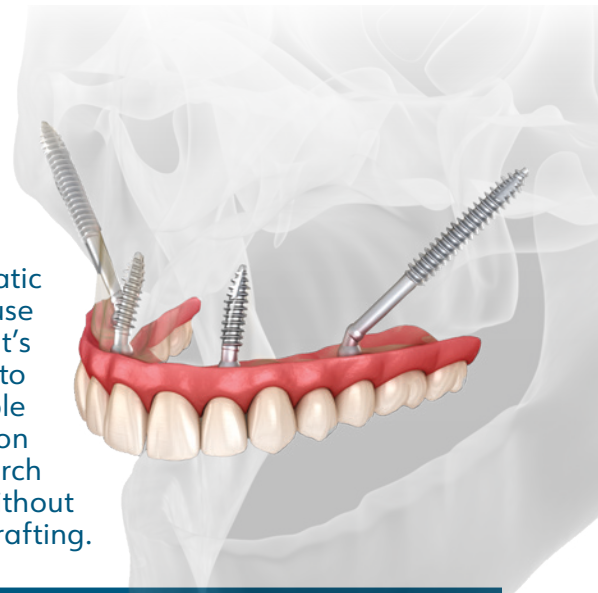

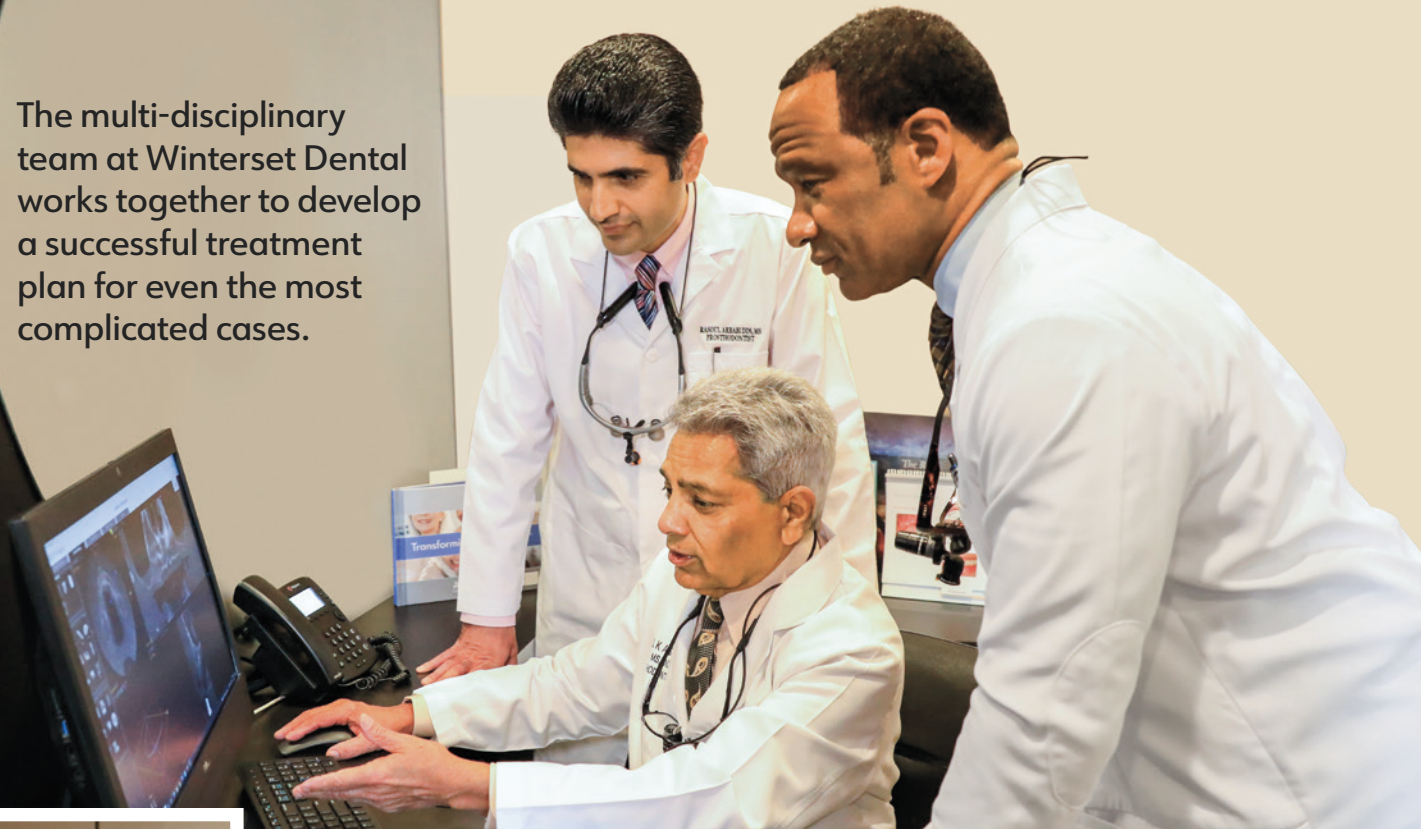

roots gradually reabsorbs. Without the stimulation of full-force chewing, bone loss continues, which leads to facial structure collapse and dentures that are loose and uncomfortable, requiring periodic readjustment.

Implant-Supported Teeth: The Ideal Solution

Dr. Agarwal's team provides implant-supported full-arch bridges, which solve the issue of progressive bone loss. The doctors can often provide a full arch of new teeth in just one day (see page 6).

With implant-supported teeth, the doctors place up to six implants per arch for maximum stability and strength. The new teeth are then attached directly to the implants. Because the teeth are securely anchored to dental implants, there is no slippage, stronger chewing power is restored and further bone loss is prevented. The lower denture won't slip or fall out when the patient is eating or speaking. With no false upper palate, implant-supported bridges allow patients to taste food again and speak normally.

"Implant-supported bridges are life-changing on many levels," says Dr. Arbabi. "We want all our patients to be able to

experience this increased quality of life." Patients who receive dentures at the office have the option of returning to upgrade to implant-supported bridges. The entire cost of their conventional dentures is applied to the implant-supported new teeth.

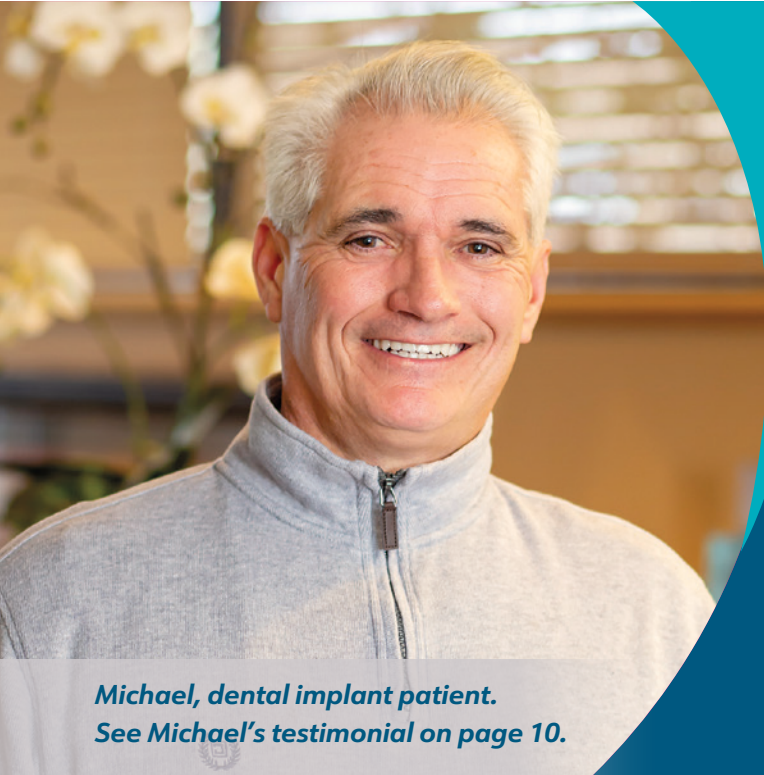
